In Case of Emergency (ICE)

Residential Life recommends that you have an ICE kit available, <u>In Case of Emergency</u>.

The following items may be very helpful:

- Flashlight/glow sticks (candles are not allowed under any circumstances)
- Extra batteries for flashlights and other electronic devices
- First Aid Kit, including gloves, bandages, antibacterial ointment (Bacitracin® or something like it), elastic bandage, ice packs, over-the-counter pain reliever, alcohol swabs, hand sanitizer, etc.)
- Pre-paid calling card, just in case cellular service is interrupted
- Extra bottled water
- List of any prescription medications you may be taking, a list of medical allergies, and your blood type
- Single-sized air mattress and travel pillow
- Other items you may wish to include: munchies, sleeping bag, an extra hat, gloves, and sweater

You should keep your ICE kit readily available in your room and if appropriate, let your roommate know where key information is kept.

Two important entries should be included in your cell phone:

- An emergency contact number, listed under ICE. This
 is helpful if someone else needs to make an
 emergency contact on your behalf.
- Alfred State University Police on your speed dial.
 Note: 911 on your cell may dial in to your home system and not Allegany County emergency services.
